

## **OVERVIEW:**

- Strong to damaging winds possible Wednesday & Thursday
- Locations all of MA, RI & CT but greatest risk is western & central Massachusetts, with the wind shift to the west Wednesday night.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Wednesday into Thursday, but strongest winds likely Wed evening/night</li> </ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Very strong to damaging west winds possible.</li> </ul>
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>Given low forecast confidence, NWS headlines are not in effect.</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Will very strong to damaging winds materialize (60+ mph) and areal coverage (isolated, widespread, etc.)? Power outages are possible.</li> </ul>
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul> <li>Very strong to damaging winds will be accompanied by rapidly falling temperatures Wed night from the 50s into the 20s in only 1-2 hrs!</li> </ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul> <li>Strong west winds persist into Thursday, with gusts 40 to 50 mph possible. This could impact power restoration.</li> <li>Potential Wind Gusts Wednesday into Thursday (10 minute of the 26, 2024 3:16 PM EST (10 minute of the 26, 2024 3:1</li></ul>
