

Heavy Rain Sat into Sat night



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Heavy rain with the potential for 2 to 3 inches with locally higher amounts, which could lead to urban, small stream and river flooding.
- Greatest risk for flooding south of the MA Pike, especially CT and RI
- Light accumulating snowfall and/or light icing across interior MA into NW CT on the front end

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow and/or freezing rain after midnight interior, changing to rain Sat AM▪ Heaviest rain Saturday afternoon through midnight▪ Rain ends late Sat night. May end as a period of snow interior N MA
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ River and stream flooding with some urban and poor drainage flooding▪ Some slippery roads late tonight into Sat AM distant interior
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Flood Watch for CT, RI and E MA including MA pike region▪ Winter Weather Advisory for central/W MA into NW CT
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Where axis of heaviest rainfall sets up▪ Extent of light icing across the interior late tonight▪ Will rain change to a period of snow Sat night interior N MA
