OVERVIEW:

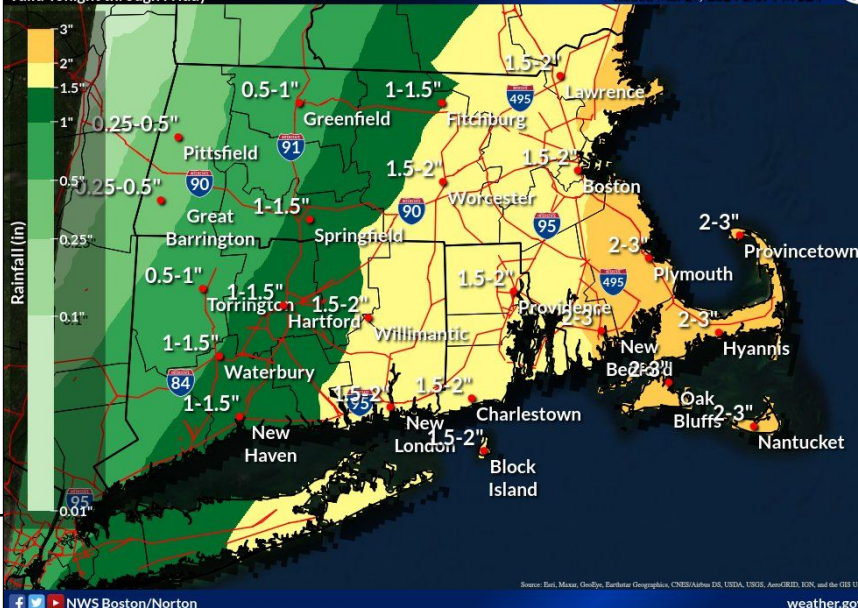
- Prolonged period of light to moderate rainfall; very wet antecedent conditions could renew river flooding
- Greatest risk for river flooding is CT, RI and perhaps into eastern MA

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Rain starting from west to east late this afternoon/evening▪ Heaviest rain Thursday and Thursday Night▪ Ending late Friday, quick burst of low impact, light snow possible Friday AM
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Renewed/prolonged river and stream flooding▪ Pockets of urban and poor drainage flooding possible
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Flood Watch in effect for central/eastern MA, RI, and eastern CT.▪ River Flood Watch in effect for the Wood River at Hope Junction
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Where the axis of heaviest rain sets up will determine the extent of renewed flooding; highest rain totals of RI and SE MA would result in greatest chance for river flooding.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Drying out late Friday▪ Dry with near seasonable temperatures this weekend▪ Gusty winds on Saturday
