

OVERVIEW:

- Prolonged period of light to moderate rainfall; very wet antecedent conditions could renew river flooding
- Greatest risk for river flooding is CT, RI and perhaps into eastern MA

TIMING	 Rain starting from west to east late this afternoon/evening Heaviest rain Thursday and Thursday Night Ending late Friday, quick burst of low impact, light snow possible Friday AM 		
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Renewed/prolonged river and stream flooding Pockets of urban and poor drainage flooding possible 		
NWS ALERTS	 Flood Watch in effect for central/eastern MA, RI, and eastern CT. River Flood Watch in effect for the Wood River at Hope Junction 		
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 Where the axis of heaviest rain sets up will determine the extent of renewed flooding; highest rain totals of RI and SE MA would result in greatest chance for river flooding.
