## OVERVIEW:

- Prolonged period of light to moderate rainfall; very wet antecedent conditions could renew river flooding
- Greatest risk for river flooding is CT, RI and perhaps into eastern MA

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Rain ongoing across western MA/CT</li><li>▪ Heaviest rain today and tonight</li><li>▪ Ending late Friday, quick burst of low impact, light snow possible Friday AM</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Renewed/prolonged river and stream flooding</li><li>▪ Pockets of urban and poor drainage flooding possible</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Flood Watch in effect for central/eastern MA, RI, and eastern CT.</li><li>▪ River Flood Watch in effect for the Wood River at Hope Valley</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Where the axis of heaviest rain sets up will determine the extent of renewed flooding; highest rain totals of RI and SE MA would result in greatest chance for river flooding.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Drying out late Friday</li><li>▪ Dry with near seasonable temperatures this weekend</li><li>▪ Gusty winds Friday night into Saturday</li></ul>

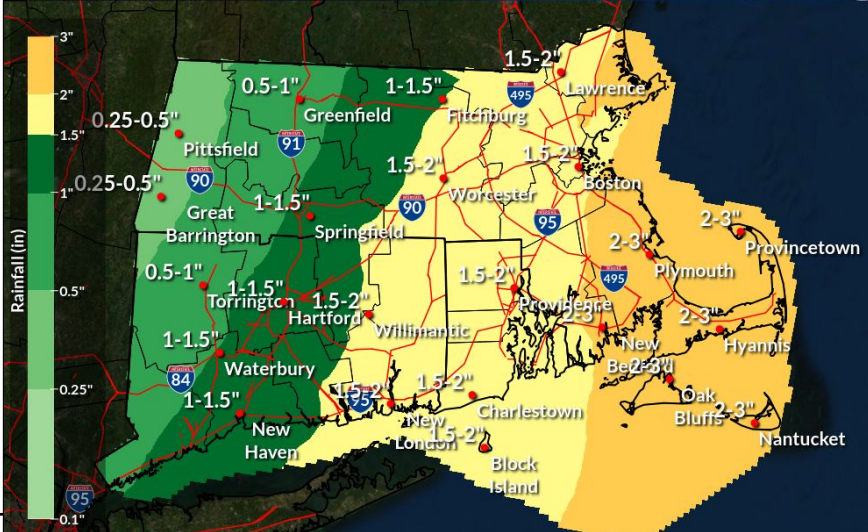
### Storm Total Rainfall
