



## OVERVIEW:

- Widespread rain develops tonight across much of the region
- Rain will be heavy at times south of I-90 & especially CT/RI
- 1-2" of rain is likely south of I-90 before it comes to an end Thu PM
- Low probability of 3-5" rain in a 6 hour period in parts of CT/RI
- Urban/Small Stream Flooding possible CT/RI with higher amounts

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Heaviest rain expected late tonight into Thursday morning</li> <li>▪ The highest rainfall amounts expected across CT/RI</li> </ul>	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Most likely just nuisance poor drainage street flooding during Thu am rush</li> <li>▪ Low risk of more significant Urban/Small Stream Flooding</li> </ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ None at this time</li> </ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The axis of heaviest rain which will probably be in a narrow corridor.</li> <li>▪ Nuisance poor drainage street flooding is the most likely outcome.</li> <li>▪ Lower probability of more significant Urban/Small Stream flooding in CT &amp; RI if the higher rainfall amounts are realized.</li> </ul>	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Rain tapers off Thursday afternoon and evening. Quiet weather follows Friday into the weekend with just a few spot showers possible at times</li> </ul>
