## Low Probability of Flooding in CT/RI



#### **OVERVIEW:**

- Widespread rain develops tonight across much of the region
- Rain will be heavy at times south of I-90 & especially CT/RI
- I-2" of rain is likely south of I-90 before it comes to an end Thu PM
- Low probability of 3-5" rain in a 6 hour period in parts of CT/RI
- Urban/Small Stream Flooding possible CT/RI with higher amounts

### TIMING

- Heaviest rain expected late tonight into Thursday morning
- The highest rainfall amounts expected across CT/RI

### IIMING

- Most likely just nuisance poor drainage street flooding during Thu am rush
- Low risk of more significant Urban/Small Stream Flooding


CHALLENGES

- Lower probability of more significant Urban/Small Stream flooding in CT & RI if the higher rainfall amounts are realized.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

Rain tapers off Thursday afternoon and evening. Quiet weather follows Friday into the weekend with just a few spot showers possible at
