- Dangerous Heat & Humidity Continues Cont. Thur & Fri
- Afternoon Heat Indices of 98 to 103 degrees.
- Pop-up thunderstorms possible Thursday afternoon
- Little relief at night with overnight Heat Indices only dropping into the 70s.

<p>TIMING</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dangerous Heat & Humidity continues Thursday and cannot rule out a few pop-up thunderstorms mainly north of the Mass Pike. ▪ Heat persists into Friday in CT and southwestern MA
<p>HAZARDS & IMPACTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Heat advisory in effect for most of southern New England, excluding the coast, through 7 PM Thursday ▪ Heat advisory in effect for <i>*only*</i> the Connecticut River Valley through 7 PM Friday
<p>FORECAST CHALLENGES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Showers and thunderstorms could inhibit maximum temperatures Thursday afternoon, leading to slightly cooler temperatures. ▪ Sea Breezes will bring relief to the immediate coastline. ▪ Persistence of heat into Friday with a cold front moving from north to south; greatest chance for prolonged heat in Connecticut.

<p>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Heat breaks Friday. Risk of scattered showers & t-storms at times over the weekend.
