



OVERVIEW:

- Severe T-Storms along with a localized Flash Flood Threat Sunday.
- Main time of concern is between 1 and 10 PM Sunday.
- Greatest risk for severe weather will be northwest of I-95.
- Damaging wind gusts, torrential rainfall/localized flash flooding, and even a few tornadoes are possible.
