


OVERVIEW:

- Strong to locally Severe Storms this Afternoon with the greatest threat being Damaging Winds
- Heavy Rain in Thunderstorms may result in localized Urban and Flash Flooding
- Greatest Storm Coverage across CT, RI and central and western MA

TIMING	▪ Saturday Afternoon; approximately between 12 PM to 8 PM	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Damaging Winds▪ Rainfall rates of over 1" per hour in slow moving thunderstorms may result in Urban/Poor Drainage and Flash Flooding▪ Storm total rainfall may reach 3" with locally higher amounts possible if storms remain stationary	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ There are currently no convective headlines in effect▪ A Heat Advisory remains in effect for CT & southwest MA, including the Greater Springfield area, for heat indices into the mid 90s.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Areal coverage and severity of thunderstorms.
