OVERVIEW:

- Strong to severe thunderstorms possible across southern New England on Sunday
- Storms may be capable of producing damaging winds and large hail
- Heavy downpours and frequent lightning are also possible

TIMING	▪ Main risk between 2 PM to 10 PM	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Large hail of 1 inch or greater diameter▪ Damaging straight-line wind gusts of 60+ mph▪ Heavy downpours could lead to urban, poor drainage, and small stream flooding	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Strongest storms more favored north and west of I-95. Will storms maintain strength as they move southeast of I-95 or weaken?	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Round of thunderstorms possible for CT and south coastal RI/MA early Sunday morning, but not expected to be strong/severe.
