- Strong to severe thunderstorms possible across southern New England today
- Storms may be capable of producing damaging winds, large hail, and perhaps a tornado
- Heavy downpours and frequent lightning are also possible

 Main risk between 2 PM to 10 PM TIMING

 Damaging straight-line wind gusts of 60+ mph Large hail of I inch or greater diameter

Heavy downpours could lead to urban, poor drainage, and small stream

flooding Low risk for an isolated tornado

maintain strength as they move southeast of I-95, or weaken?


