



OVERVIEW:

- Little relief in the heat tonight, with overnight Heat Indices dropping into the 70s.
- Dangerous Heat on Tuesday, afternoon heat indices range from 95 to 100 degrees.
- Isolated strong to severe storms possible Tuesday afternoon and evening.

TIMING

- Heat persists through Tuesday.
- Isolated severe storm risk from 2-10 PM Tuesday.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Heat Advisory for much of CT, central/northern RI, and portions of MA.
- Heavy downpours may lead to localized street flooding.
- Localized damaging wind gusts.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Portions of the advisory might need to be extended into Wednesday.
- Areal coverage of both severe weather & heavy rain/street flooding.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Slightly lower temps for rest of week, but humidity remains.
- Unsettled with showers and storms.
