


# High Surf and Dangerous Rips Today

## OVERVIEW:

- High surf and dangerous rip currents expected along the coastline today.
- Risk greatest across eastern facing beaches.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Wave action peaks this morning into the early afternoon before quickly diminishing tonight.</li><li>▪ High rip current risk throughout the day across eastern facing beaches.</li><li>▪ Moderate rip current risk for southern facing beaches.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Rough surf and high risk of rip currents.</li><li>▪ Inexperienced and panicked swimmers could drown.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ No changes since last update. High Surf Advisory and Rip Current Statements remain in effect.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ How quickly rip current risk diminishes Sunday. Widespread moderate at this time.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<div><div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ High pressure builds in through the week.
