OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snowfall is expected in interior southern New England Wed night into early Thurs, with mainly rain along the I-95 corridor.
- 2-5" of snow in interior MA, with up to 6" possible in the highest terrain.
- After snow dissipates, northwest winds then increase Thurs afternoon and remain gusty through Fri.

| TIMING | Snow: Begins after the Wed PM commute, peaking during the Wed overnight into early Thurs AM before tapering off Thurs late AM. Gusty NW Winds: Increase late Thurs PM, peaking during the evening/overnight before easing into Fri. |
