

Snow & Gusty Winds Dec 4-6





WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snowfall is expected in interior southern New England tonight into early Thurs, with mainly rain along the I-95 corridor.
- 2-6" of snow in interior MA and northern hills of CT.
- Potential for impactful snow squall across interior SNE on Thurs.
- Strong west winds increase Thurs PM and remain gusty through Fri.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow: Arrives between 7-11 PM tonight, peaks overnight through early morning hours before tapering off by late morning. Snow squall remain possible across interior SNE through Thurs PM.▪ Gusty West Winds: Increase this evening for Cape/Islands. Winds for rest of SNE peak Thurs before easing into Fri.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Difficult travel overnight into the Thurs AM commute from snow-covered roads & low visibility.▪ Isolated tree & powerline damage from gusty NW winds late on Thurs into Fri.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisories for western and central MA and portions of northern CT from 8 PM today to 10 AM Thurs.▪ Wind Advisory for Cape and Islands from tonight to Thurs PM.▪ Wind Advisory for western and central MA and all of CT for Thurs AM into Thurs PM
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Rain could flip to snow northwest of the I-95 corridor for the Thurs AM commute.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Cold, windy, and mostly dry weather expected into the weekend.
