




OVERVIEW:

- 1.5 to 2.5 inches of rain with localized amounts over 3 inches Wed into Wed night
- Strong to damaging wind gusts along the coast late Wed into Wed night

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Rain begins late Tue night and continues Wed. The heaviest rainfall and strongest winds will be late Wed into Wed evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Localized urban and poor drainage street flooding possible▪ Wind gusts of 50-60 mph possible which may cause some power outages and tree damage.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ High Wind Watch for coastal southern New England late Wed into Wed night.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Axis of heaviest rainfall is uncertain and location may shift▪ How strong will wind gusts be and do stronger wind gusts expand further inland?
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div><div><ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Blustery and colder Thursday▪ Dry with below normal temperatures Friday and Saturday</div><div></div></div>
