



OVERVIEW:

- 2-3” of rain with localized amounts up to 4” Wed into Wed night
- High Wind Warning for eastern MA & southern RI Wed/Wed night
- Wind Advisory for the remainder of MA, RI & CT Wed/Wed night
- Flood Watch Western MA/parts of northern CT

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Rain develops late Tuesday night. The heaviest rainfall and strongest winds will be late Wed into Wed evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Mainstem River Flooding possible western MA & CT▪ Pockets of Localized Urban Flooding possible too▪ Southerly wind gusts of 50-60 mph possible across eastern MA & srn RI
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ High Wind Warning eastern MA & srn RI late Wed/Wed night.▪ Flood Watch Western MA & parts of northern CT▪ Storm Watch for all waters late Wed/Wed night.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Axis of heaviest rainfall is likely across CT/western-central MA, but location may shift farther eastward into RI and eastern MA▪ Amount of Snowmelt in northern New England will impact River Flooding Potential in southern New England.▪ Do stronger wind gusts expand further inland, northwest of I-95?
