- High Wind Warning for eastern MA & RI later today into tonight.
- Wind Advisory for much of western/central MA & northern CT
- Flood Watch for much of Southern New England

TIMING

 Periods of Heavy rain through this evening. The heaviest rainfall and strongest winds will be late today into this evening.

IMPACTS

HAZARDS &

 Some Stream & Mainstem River Flooding possible Pockets of Localized Urban Flooding possible too

- - Southerly wind gusts of 45-60 mph
- High Wind Warning eastern MA & RI later today into tonight
- Flood Watch for much of southern New England later today & tonight.
- Storm Warning with southerly wind gusts up to 55 kts for our waters.

- Axis of heaviest rain and if we see any 4"+ amounts Amount of Snowmelt in northern New England will impact River Flooding
- Potential in southern New England. • How far west do the strongest winds get?
