- 2-3” of rain with localized amounts of 4”+ possible into this evening.
- High Wind Warning for eastern MA & RI later today into tonight.
- Wind Advisory for much of western/central MA & northern CT
- Flood Watch for much of Southern New England

TIMING	▪ Periods of Heavy rain through this evening. The heaviest rainfall and strongest winds will be late today into this evening.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Some Stream & Mainstem River Flooding possible ▪ Pockets of Localized Urban Flooding possible too ▪ Southerly wind gusts of 45-60 mph	
NWS ALERTS	▪ High Wind Warning eastern MA & RI later today into tonight ▪ Flood Watch for much of southern New England later today & tonight. ▪ Storm Warning with southerly wind gusts up to 55 kts for our waters.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Axis of heaviest rain and if we see any 4”+ amounts ▪ Amount of Snowmelt in northern New England will impact River Flooding Potential in southern New England. ▪ How far west do the strongest winds get?
