 Light icing develops early Saturday morning in interior Southern New England before changing to plain rain. Impacts solely to travel.

TIMING	 Starting pre-dawn Saturday (~4-6 AM), gradually improving into
	the late morning to early afternoon as temperatures warm.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Slippery travel from a light glazing of ice on untreated roads.
NWS ALERTS	• Winter Weather Advisories from 4 AM Saturday to 1 PM Saturday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 How long will it take for lower-elevation valley areas (CT & Merrimack) to rise above freezing? Might we see plain rain fall on cold pavement and produce slick spots in the Boston/Providence I-95 corridor?
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	 Milder Saturday and Sunday with periods of rain, drizzle and fog. Forecast Ice Accumulations Value 4 AM Saturday through 1 PM Saturday. Out-on- Provincetown Boston Out-on- Great Out-on- Barrington Out-on- Bar
