


# Strong/Possibly Damaging Wind Gusts

## OVERVIEW:

- Strong and possibly damaging wind gusts of 45 to 55 mph are expected from early tonight into Thursday.
- Strongest winds will occur on Thursday when some locations could see gusts as high as 60 mph.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Wind gusts increase this evening with the strongest winds expected on Thursday before subsiding Thursday evening.</li></ul>	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Downed branches, power lines, and weakened trees. Power outages are possible.</li><li>Hazardous wind and sea conditions on the MA/RI coastal waters.</li></ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Wind Advisory for Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Rhode Island.</li></ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Confidence in how widespread 60 mph gusts.</li></ul>	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Below-normal temperatures return Friday through the weekend. Highs on Friday will be in the 30s, with the possibility of sub-freezing highs this weekend.</li><li>Gusts of 20 to 30 mph continue through the weeknd.</li></ul>
