

Strong/Possibly Damaging Wind Gusts

OVERVIEW:

- Strong and possibly damaging wind gusts of 45 to 55 mph are expected from early tonight into Thursday.
- Strongest winds will occur on Thursday when some locations could see gusts as high as 60 mph.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Wind gusts increase this evening with the strongest winds expected on Thursday before subsiding Thursday evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Downed branches, power lines, and weakened trees. Power outages are possible.Hazardous wind and sea conditions on the MA/RI coastal waters.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Wind Advisory for Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Rhode Island.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Confidence in how widespread 60 mph gusts will be is currently too low for a High Wind Warning. If confidence increases, some areas could be upgraded to a High Wind Warning later today.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Below-normal temperatures I return Friday through the weekend. Highs on Friday will be in the 30s, with the possibility of sub-freezing highs this weekend.Gusts of 20 to 30 mph continue through the weeknd.
