Winter Weather Briefing

For NWS Boston County Warning Area

Decision Support Briefing

Issued at: 7:30 AM Jan 18th, 2025

Next Scheduled Briefing: By 6 AM [Sun Jan 19th]

Key Messages

- Growing confidence on 6" or more snow totals north and west of I-95 Sunday afternoon into early Monday, though the location of the exact maximum from snowbands is uncertain.
- Increasing confidence of at least plowable snowfall for the BOS-PVD I-95 corridor.
- Well below normal temperatures and hazardous wind chills early next week.

Important Updates

- → Winter Storm Watches Converted to Winter Storm Warnings for Hartford and Tolland Counties in CT & most of western, central and northeast MA.
- → Increased snow amounts into the Boston-Providence I-95 corridor, with Winter Storm Watches posted.


 Most of Southern New England

Confidence Levels

Timing

Sun afternoon through early Mon morning. Snow should come to an end before Mon AM commute. Potential for rates (1-2"/hour) in banded snow Sun evening/night.

Increased confidence on accumulating, plowable snow but less confidence on location & placement of bands of heavier snow.


Travel Impacts




High probability for **at least** minor impacts (snow covered roads and slippery travel) for Monday AM commute. Potential for areas of hazardous travel Sun night.





Snow Amounts








Snowfall Onset Timing


Snow will overspread the area Sunday late afternoon and early evening

Bitter Cold Arrives Next Week

- Arctic outbreak brings well below normal temperatures to region next week.
- Coldest air Monday through Wednesday
- Hazardous wind chills (see next slide)

Minimum Wind Chills

- Hazardous wind chills expected, aided by marginally breezy conditions.
- Wind chills 0 to -10F. Potentially as low as -20F in the Berkshires Mon, Tue, Weds night.
 - Near Cold Weather Advisory criteria.
