

Snow This Evening into Monday AM

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Quick hitting clipper system brings accumulating snow to the region this evening and ends early Monday morning.
- Widespread 2-4" of snow across most of southern New England with lesser amounts of 1-2" across eastern Massachusetts.
- Localized higher amounts of 5" in the Berkshires.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow starts west to east between 7 PM and 9 PM.▪ Snow concludes west to east between 2 AM and 4 AM.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Hazardous driving conditions overnight due to snow covered roadways as snow may become briefly heavy at times late this evening.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory for most of Connecticut (excluding the coast), western and central Massachusetts, and northern Rhode Island.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Could the higher snow amounts shift further east, leading to an additional inch of snow across Rhode Island and eastern Massachusetts.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Mild afternoon temperatures in the low to mid-40s
