


OVERVIEW:

- A winter storm will bring snow, transitioning to sleet and freezing rain Thursday. 1 to 4 inches of snow is expected along with some minor ice accumulation.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow starts between 7 and 10 AM, heaviest between 9 AM - 1 PM from west to east.▪ Precipitation ending between 4 and 8 PM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 1 to 4 inches of snow for most locations, before switching to few hours of sleet & freezing rain. Precipitation ends as rain towards the south coast of RI and southeast MA.▪ Temperatures will remain below freezing northwest of I-95.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory for all of southern New England, except Cape Cod and the islands.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How quickly the snow changes over will impact exact snowfall accumulations.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div><ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Friday will be windy with temperatures in the 20s and 30s. Wind gusts 35-50 mph!</div>
