

# Snow Saturday Night into Sunday

## OVERVIEW:

- A winter storm will bring the potential for heavy snow Saturday night, tapering off Sunday morning
- Potential for 6+ inches of snow.
- Confidence that we will see a plowable snowfall is high, but confidence in snowfall totals is low to moderate. Confidence in timing is high.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Snow most likely arrives between 8 PM Saturday to midnight Sunday.</li> <li>▪ Snow ends by Sunday afternoon into early evening.</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Plowable snow is likely.</li> <li>▪ Potential for 6+ inches of snow.</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A Winter Storm Watch is in effect for all of SNE except for the islands.</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ If the system tracks farther, south snow totals will be less.</li> <li>▪ Potential for some mixing towards the south coast of New England</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Snow ends by Sunday afternoon into early evening. Next potential system doesn't arrive until late Tuesday.</li> </ul>
