

Snow Saturday Night into Sunday



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- A winter storm will bring the potential for heavy snow Saturday night, tapering off Sunday morning
- Potential for 6+ inches of snow.
- Confidence that we will see a plowable snowfall is high, but confidence in snowfall totals is low to moderate. Confidence in timing is high.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow most likely arrives between 8 PM Saturday to midnight Sunday.▪ Snow ends by Sunday afternoon into early evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Plowable snow is likely.▪ Potential for 6+ inches of snow.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A Winter Storm Watch is in effect for all of SNE except for the islands.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ If the system tracks farther, south snow totals will be less.▪ Potential for some mixing towards the south coast of New England
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div data-bbox="262 1147 491 1630"><ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow ends by Sunday afternoon into early evening. Next potential system doesn't arrive until late Tuesday.</div> <div data-bbox="511 1116 1428 1812"></div>
