## Snow Saturday Night into Sunday



## **OVERVIEW:**

- A winter storm will bring the potential for heavy snow Saturday night, tapering off Sunday morning
- Potential for 6+ inches of snow.
- Confidence that we will see a plowable snowfall is high, but confidence in snowfall totals is low to moderate. Confidence in timing is high.

TIMING

- Snow most likely arrives between 8 PM Saturday to midnight Sunday.
  Snow ends by Sunday afternoon into early evening.


