### Key Messages

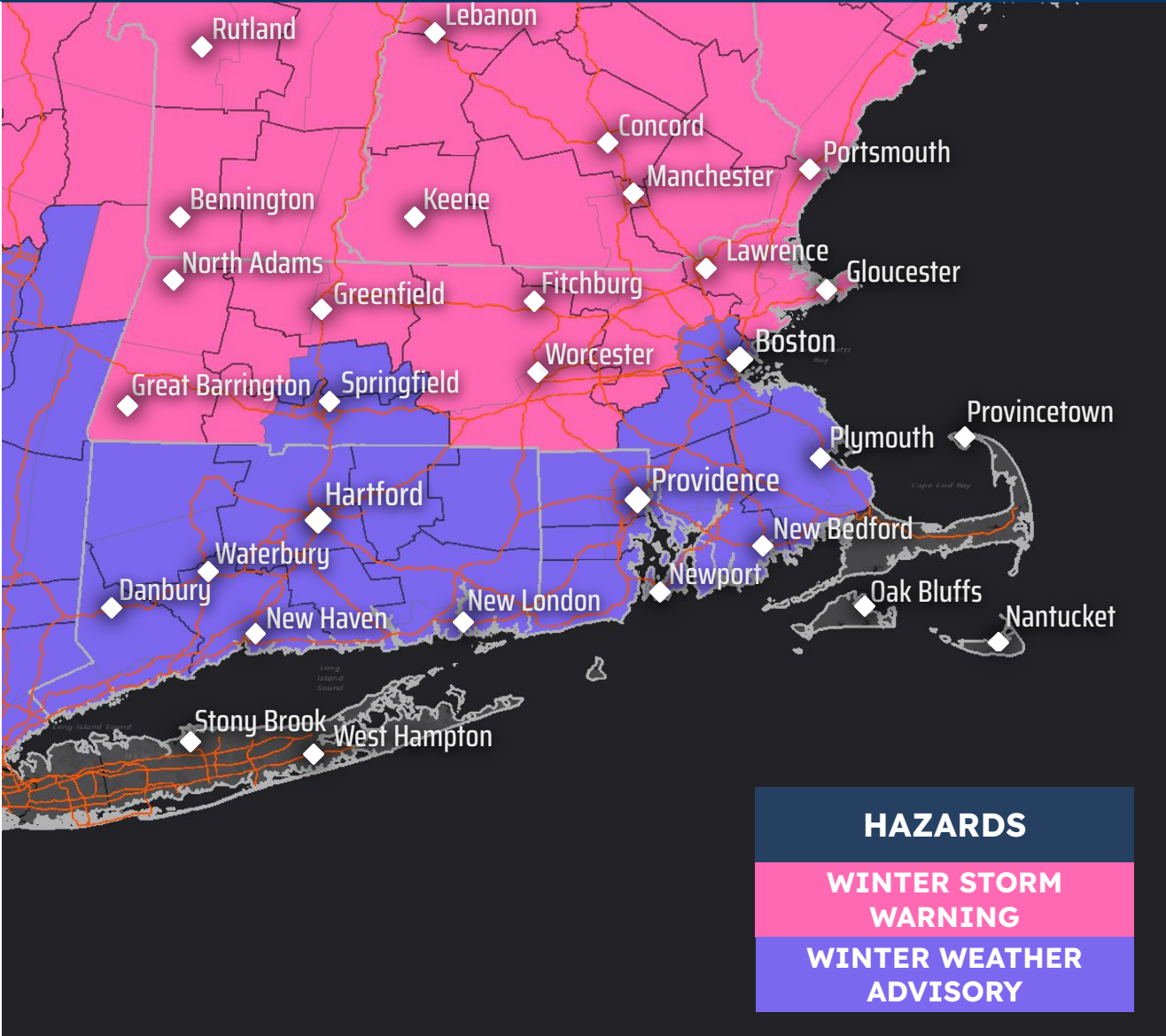
- Mainly rain across eastern MA/RI by mid-late Sun AM with street flooding possible.

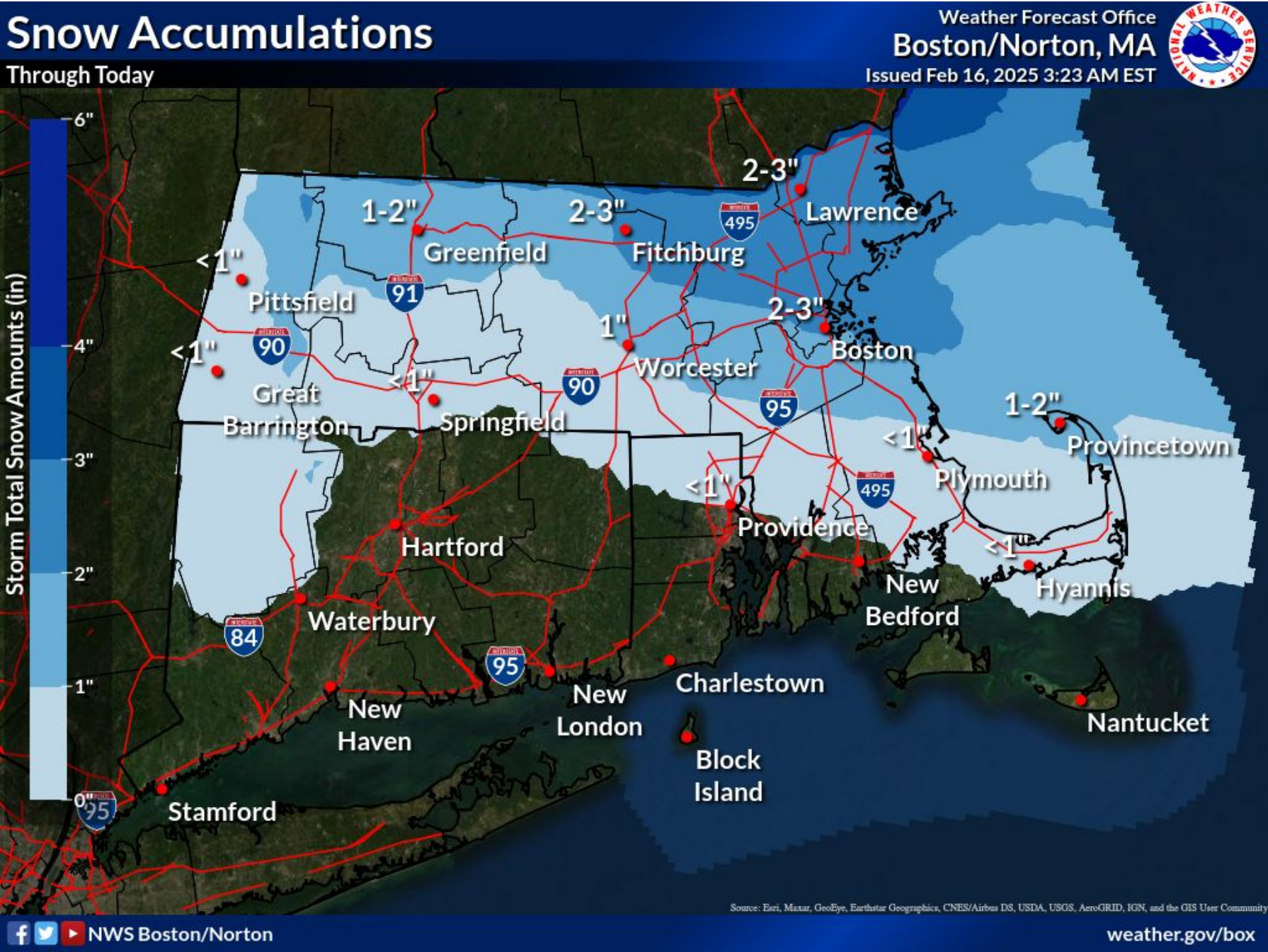

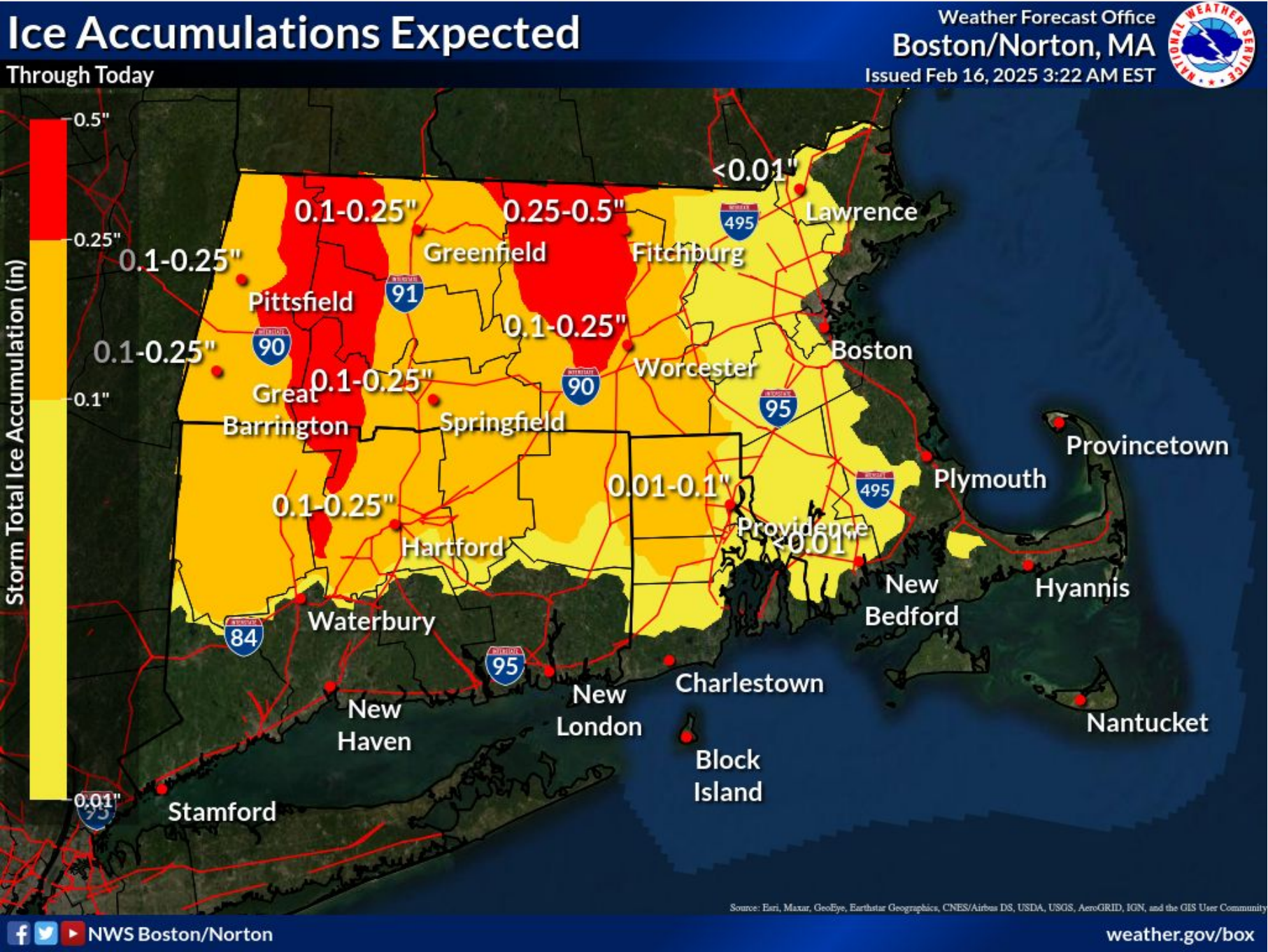






# Total Ice Accumulation

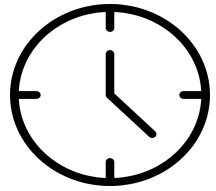

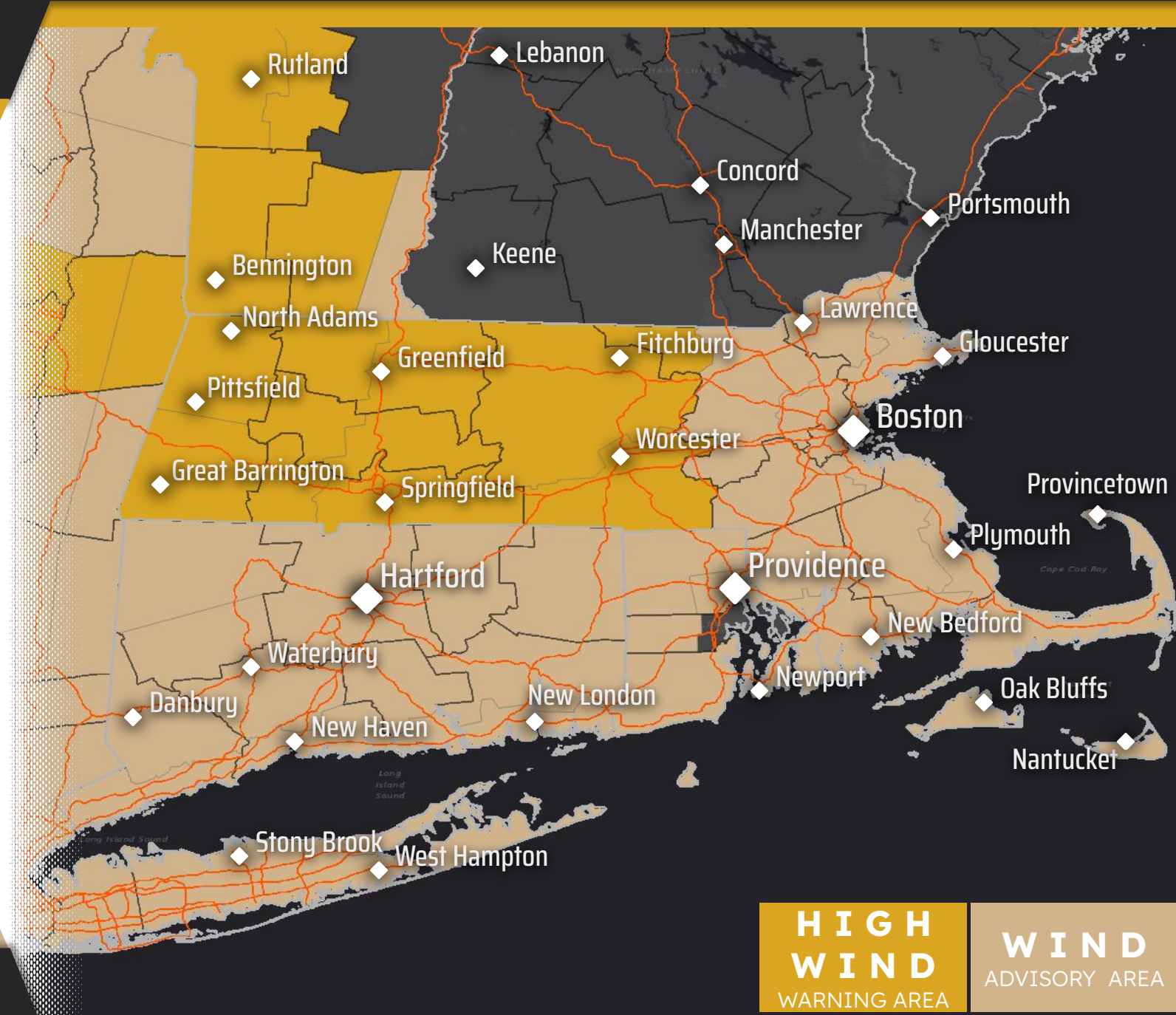

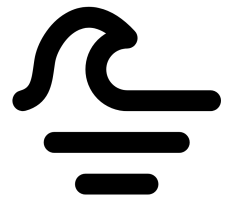

- 34-63 KT possible

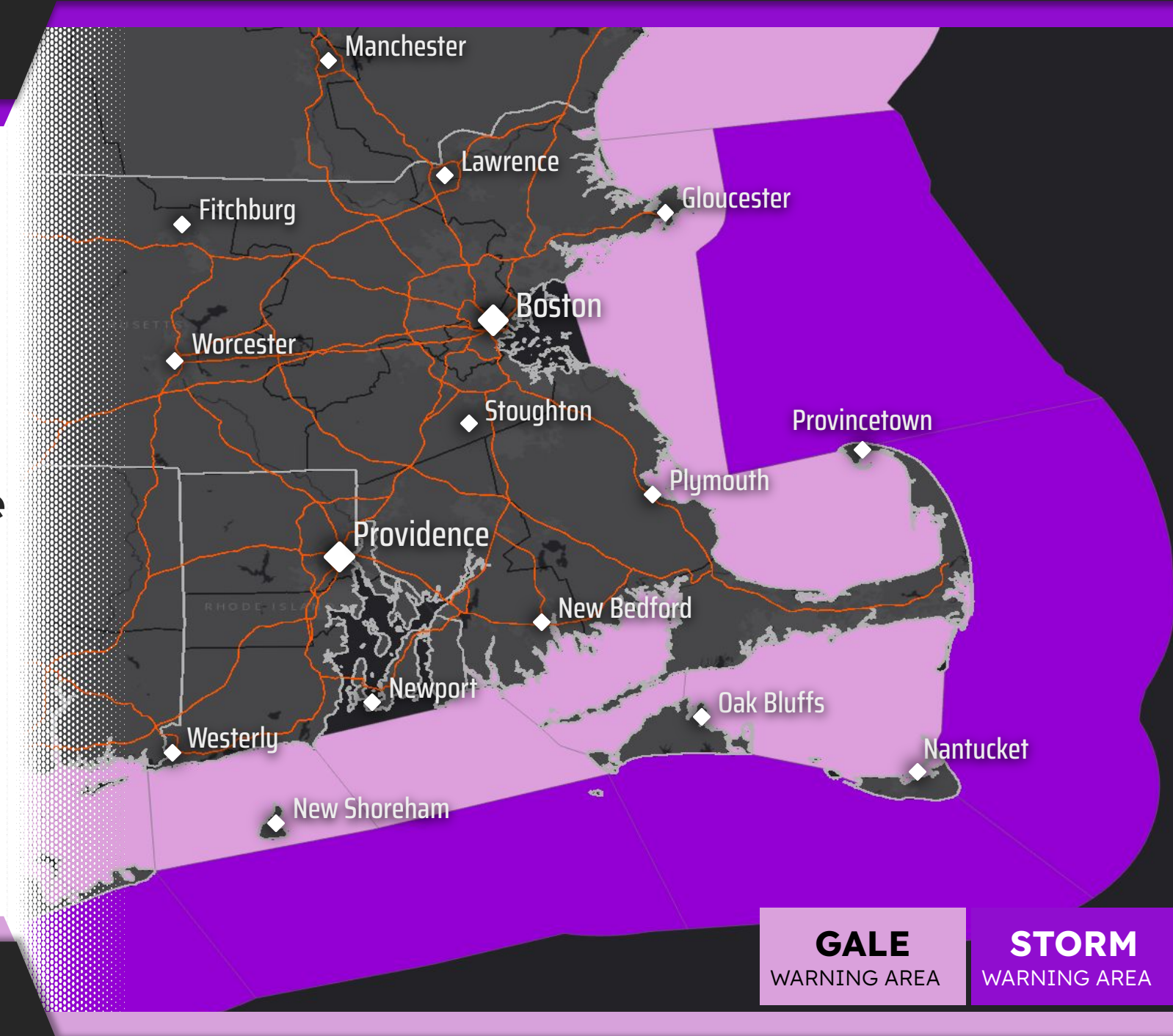


- Wind and wave conditions will be hazardous for small craft.

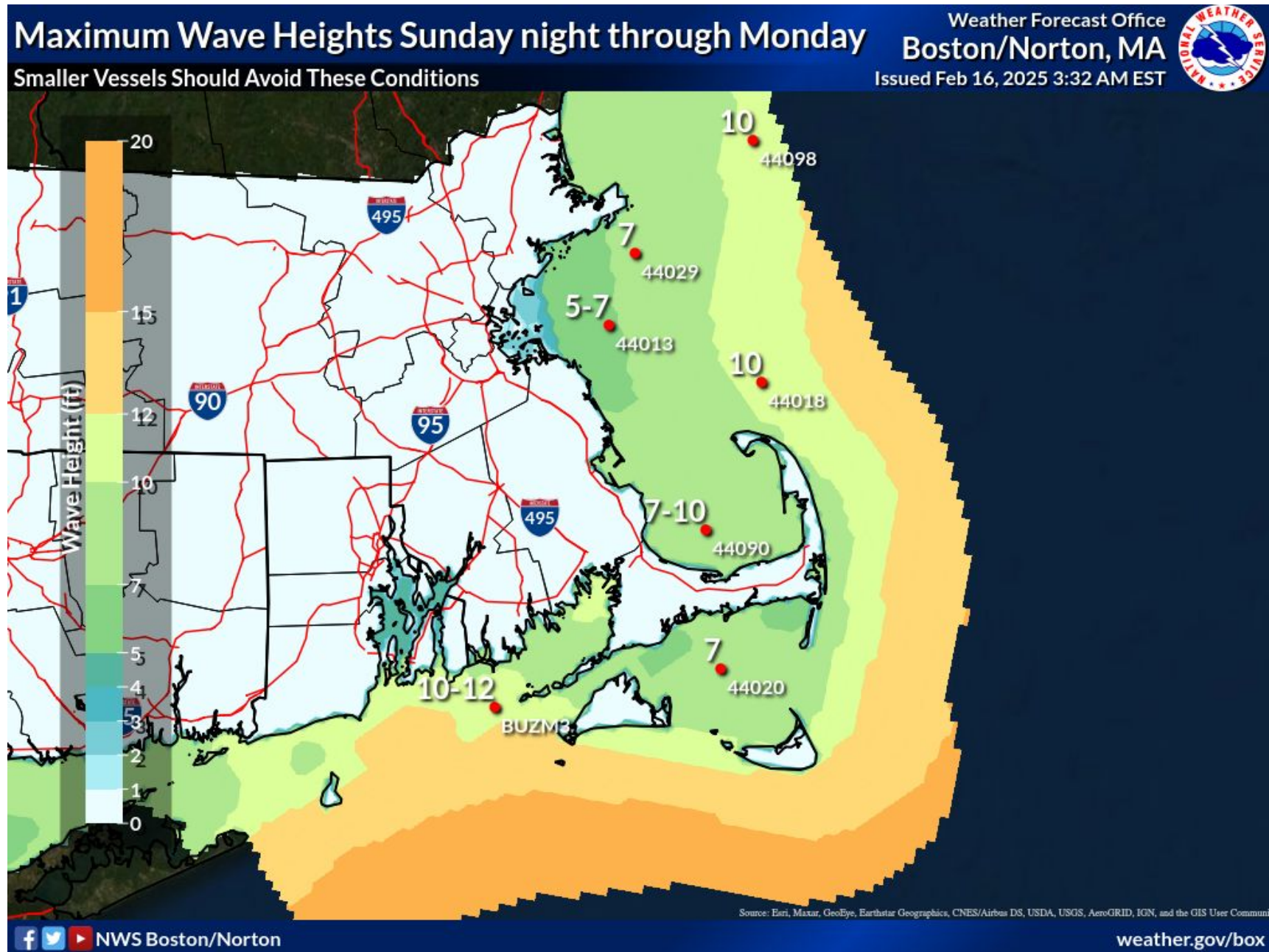

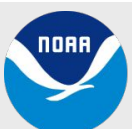


# Marine Conditions Sun Night & Monday

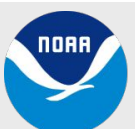
