


Strong/Possibly Damaging Wind Gusts

OVERVIEW:

- Strong and possibly damaging peak wind gusts of 55 to 65 mph are expected.
- Sustained west winds of 15 to 30 mph.

TIMING	▪ Gusts increase mainly after midnight and continue through Monday evening.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Downed branches, power lines, and weakened trees. Power outages are possible.▪ Hazardous wind and sea conditions on the MA/RI coastal waters.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ High Wind Warning all of MA except for southeast MA▪ Wind Advisory for CT, RI and southeast MA▪ Storm Warnings for the eastern MA and outer RI coastal waters▪ Gale Warnings for south coastal RI and MA waters	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Most confident towards northern New England. Lower confidence towards the south coast.
