

## **OVERVIEW:**

- Strong, potentially damaging peak wind gusts of 40 to 60 mph are expected.
- Sustained west winds of 15 to 30 mph.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Strong winds persist this evening through Tuesday afternoon</li> </ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Downed branches, power lines, and weakened trees. Power outages are possible.</li> <li>Hazardous wind and sea conditions on the MA/RI coastal waters.</li> </ul>
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>High Wind Warnings remain in effect but will likely be downgraded to Wind Advisories for Tuesday</li> <li>Storm Warnings for the eastern MA and outer RI coastal waters through early Tuesday morning</li> <li>Gale Warnings for south coastal RI and MA waters</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	How soon will wind speeds fall below advisory criteria?
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul> <li>Below normal temperatures most of this week.</li> <li>Low chance for accumulating snow across southeastern MA/RI on Thursday</li> </ul>
