OVERVIEW:

- Strong to locally damaging northwest wind gusts develop tonight into Friday.
- Gusts 45-50 mph in lower elevations, but gusts to 60 mph expected in the eastern slopes of the Berkshires and central MA.

TIMING

Gusts increase 6-8 PM tonight. Peak of the wind gusts midnight to 5 PM
 Friday in the higher elevations, and peak gusts in lower elevations around 5
 AM to 5 PM Friday.
