Strong Northwest Winds Today



OVERVIEW:

- Strong to locally damaging northwest wind gusts continue through this afternoon.
- Gusts 45-50 mph in lower elevations, but gusts to 60 mph expected in the Berkshires and central MA.

TIMING

 Ongoing; peak of the winds starting around sunrise and continue thru mid-afternoon. Decreasing gusts late this afternoon.

HAZARDS &

IMPACTS

 Downed trees and powerlines, possible anywhere but particularly in the high terrain. Possible damage to structures.

Hazardous conditions for mariners.

NWS ALERTS

 High Wind Warning: Through 7 PM today for the Berkshires and central MA

• Wind Advisory: Through 7 PM today for the rest of Southern New

England.

FORECAST CHALLENGES Another period of strong northwest gusts of 45-50 mph is possible on Saturday, which could prompt additional wind headlines.

POST-EVENT

OUTLOOK

Second surge of gusts in the 40-50 mph range Sat could hamper power restoration efforts.

Otherwise, dry with seasonably cold temperatures this weekend.
