



OVERVIEW:

- Pockets of light freezing rain likely in the highest terrain of northern MA Saturday and especially Saturday night.
- Ice accretion a trace to less than 0.10” expected, but a low risk for 0.10”-0.20” inch in the far northern Worcester Hills.

TIMING	▪ Spotty light freezing possible Saturday in the highest terrain with the greatest concern Saturday night.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Hazardous travel from icing on untreated roads mainly for elevations near and above 1000 feet. ▪ Isolated downed tree limbs if icing approaches 0.25”...low probability.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Winter Weather Advisory for the high terrain of the Berkshires and northern Worcester Hills. ▪ Primary area of concern is elevations near and above 1000 feet.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ How much ice accretion will occur on roadways with marginal temperatures around 30-32 degrees and recent mild weather.
