

Heavy Rainfall Overnight into Tuesday

OVERVIEW:

- Several rounds of heavy rain and embedded thunderstorms are expected to affect parts of interior southern New England from tonight through Tuesday.
- Rainfall totals of 1.75 to 2.5 inches are expected through Tuesday evening, with locally higher amounts up to 4 inches possible in areas where downpours persist.

TIMING	▪ Monday evening through Tuesday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Excessive runoff may lead to flooding of rivers, creeks, streams, and other low-lying or flood-prone areas. Waterways could rise above their banks, and storm drains or ditches may become blocked by debris.
NWS ALERTS	▪ A Flood Watch is in effect from 8 PM Monday through 8 PM Tuesday for central and western Massachusetts and all of northern Connecticut.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ May need to expand the Flood Watch into eastern Massachusetts and Rhode Island if greater rainfall totals develop.
