

## **OVERVIEW:**

- A round of strong to potentially severe storms is expected to move through southern New England this afternoon into early this evening.
- The main threats are damaging winds and large hail, but a tornado can't be ruled out in Northwestern MA/CT.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Widely scattered, non-severe thunderstorms between 9 AM to Noon.</li> <li>Greatest risk for severe thunderstorms between 2 and 8 PM, especially in western MA and northern CT.</li> </ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Winds capable of downing trees and powerlines and possible damage to structures.</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>None at this time.</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>How far east might the severe weather risk extend to?</li> <li>Cloud cover could limit severe weather potential.</li> </ul>
