

OVERVIEW:

- Severe storms may bring wind damage and flooding rain to southern New England Friday afternoon and evening.
- Storms should be more numerous near and north of the Mass Pike (I-90).

TIMING	 Greatest risk for severe thunderstorms between 2 and 8 PM. 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Wind damage including downed trees and wires. Localized gusts of 60-70 mph possible. Flooded or impassable roads, especially ones that tend to flood in heavy rain. 	
NWS ALERTS	 None at this time. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 Do we see more coverage of storms south of the Mass Pike (I-90) or do they remain along and to the north where our confidence is higher? 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	 Scattered showers linger through the weekend.
