OVERVIEW:

- Severe storms may bring wind damage and flooding rain to southern New England Friday afternoon and evening.
- Storms should be more numerous near and north of the Mass Pike (I-90).

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Greatest risk for severe thunderstorms between 2 and 8 PM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Wind damage including downed trees and wires. Localized gusts of 60-70 mph possible.Flooded or impassable roads, especially ones that tend to flood in heavy rain.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">None at this time.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Do we see more coverage of storms south of the Mass Pike (I-90) or do they remain along and to the north where our confidence is higher?
