

Severe Storms & Flooding Possible



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Severe storms may bring wind damage and flooding rain to southern New England this afternoon and evening.
- Localized flash flooding possible. Flood Watch issued for western, central, and interior northeast MA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Greatest risk for severe thunderstorms between 12 PM and 10 PM, particularly between 2 PM and 8 PM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Wind damage including downed trees and wires. Localized gusts of 60-70 mph possible.Flooded or impassable roads, especially ones that tend to flood in heavy rain.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Flood Watch in effect this afternoon and evening.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Do we see more coverage of storms south of the Mass Pike (I-90) or do they remain along and to the north where our confidence is higher?
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div><div><ul style="list-style-type: none">Scattered showers and isolated t-storms Saturday, but severe weather not expected.</div><div></div></div>
