

Severe T-Storms Possible Late Thu

OVERVIEW:

- Scattered severe thunderstorms possible late Thursday and Thursday evening with the greatest risk interior MA/CT.
- Damaging straight line wind gusts are the main concern with a secondary concern for large hail and a brief tornado.
- Torrential rainfall and localized street flooding possible too.

TIMING	▪ Main threat for severe thunderstorms is between 2 and 10 PM Thursday with a focus for interior MA/CT.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Downed trees and wires are possible in any severe thunderstorm. ▪ Isolated reports of large hail and a brief tornado are possible. ▪ Pockets of torrential rainfall may lead to street flooding especially in urban areas.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ How far east the severe weather threat will extend. ▪ The areal coverage and timing of the thunderstorms.
