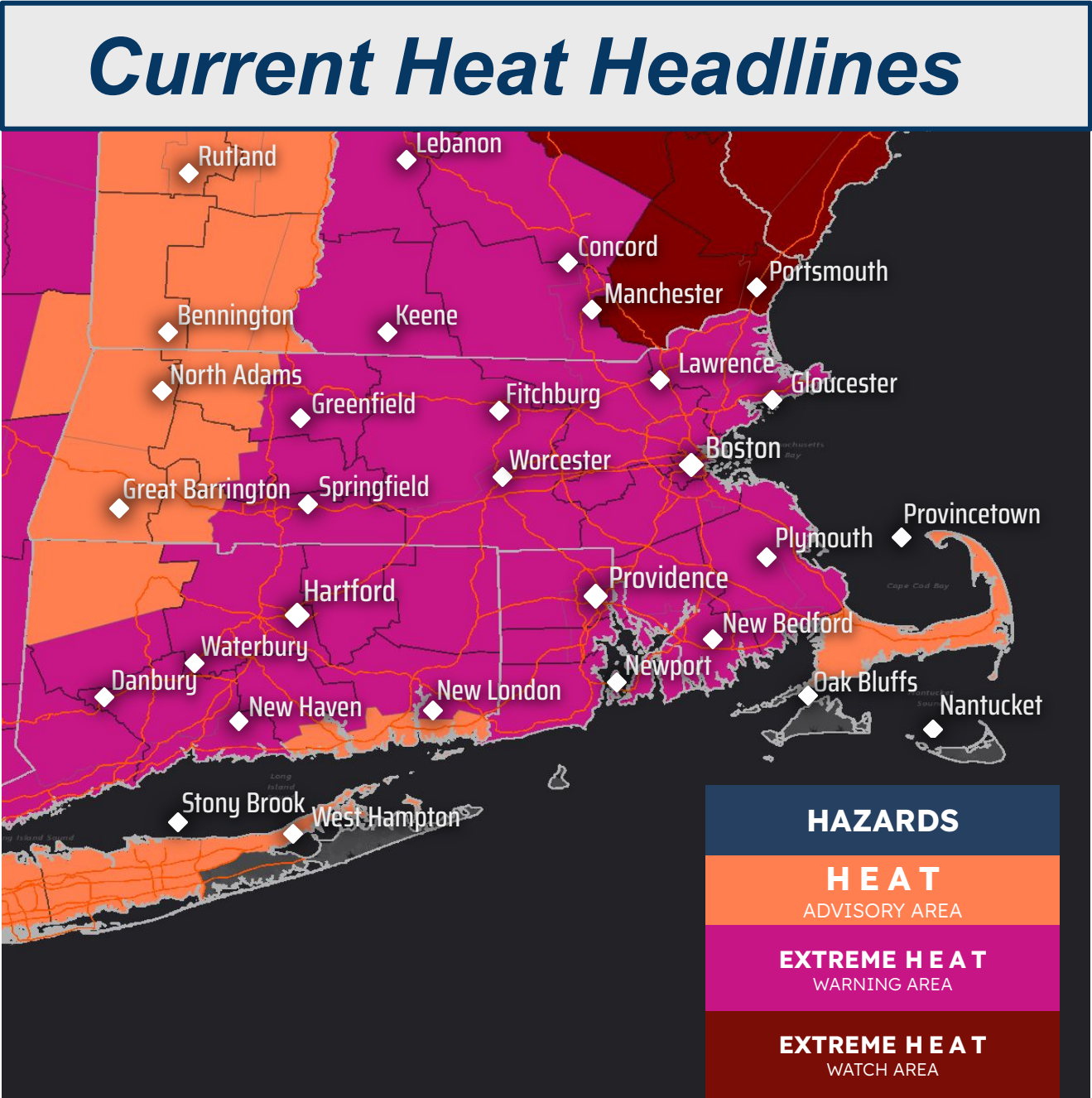
Key Messages

- Dangerous heat and humidity through Tuesday
- Peak of the heat/humidity is Tuesday, with “Feels Like” temperatures 105-110F in many areas
- Still hot Wednesday, but heat eases with peak heat indices 95-100F. Heat Advisories may be needed for a portion of the area
- Relief arrives by Thursday. Highs in the 70s to lower 80s

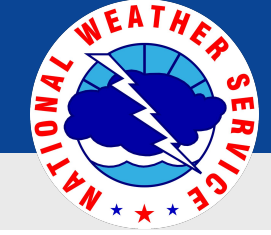

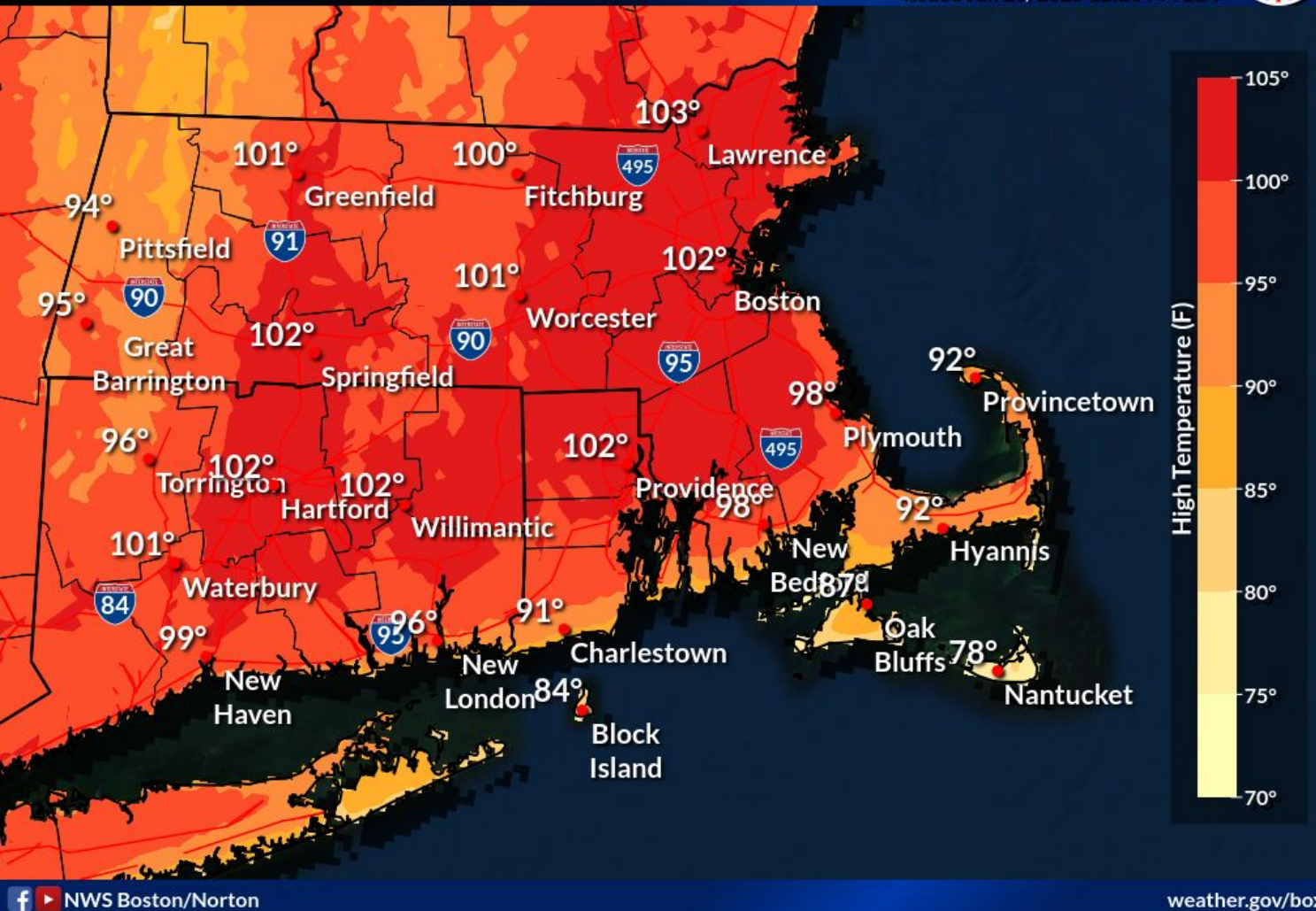

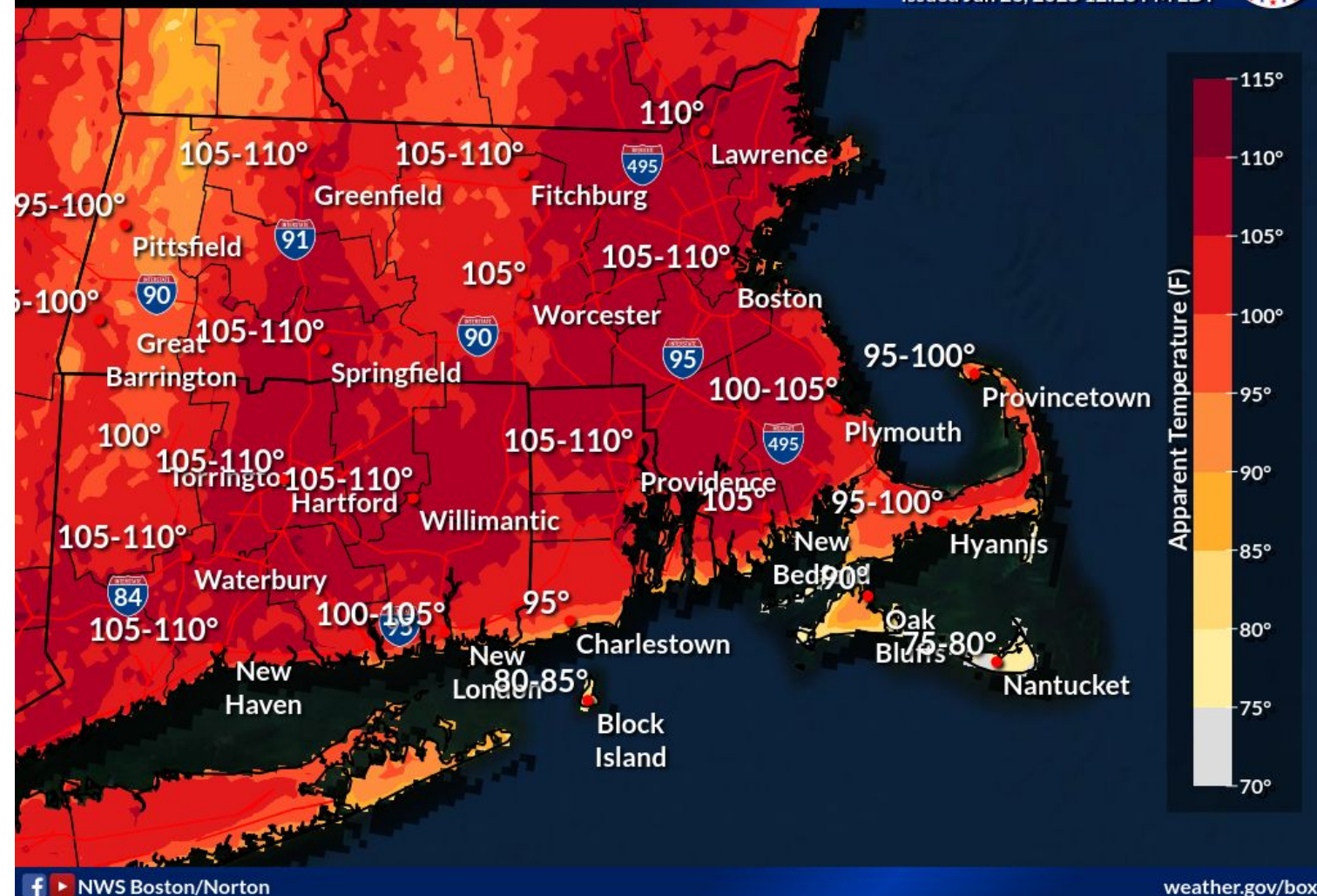

Tuesday - Maximum "Feels Like" Temperatures

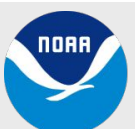

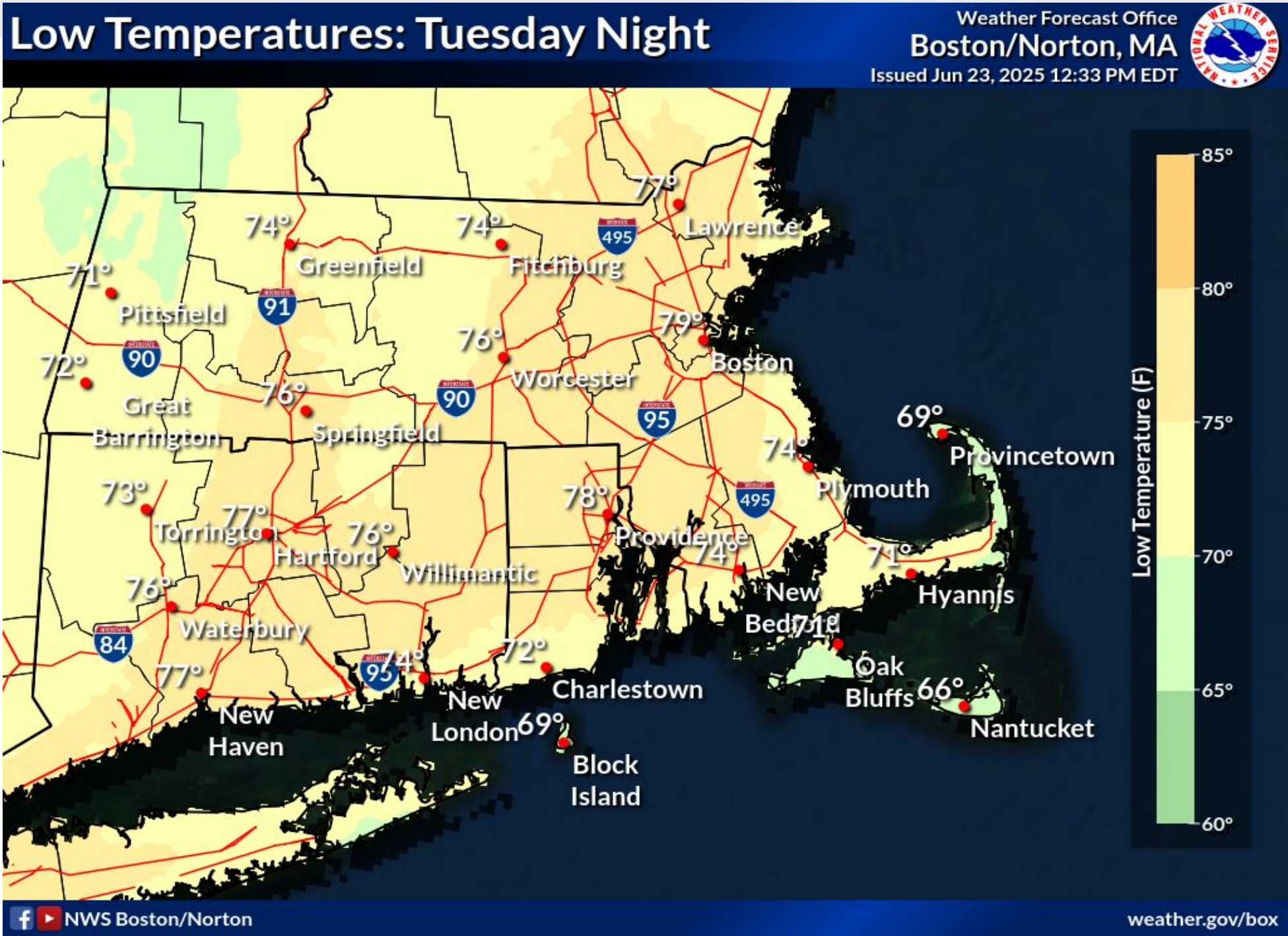

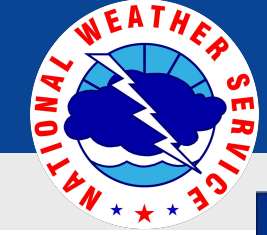

Overnight Low Temperatures: Tuesday Night

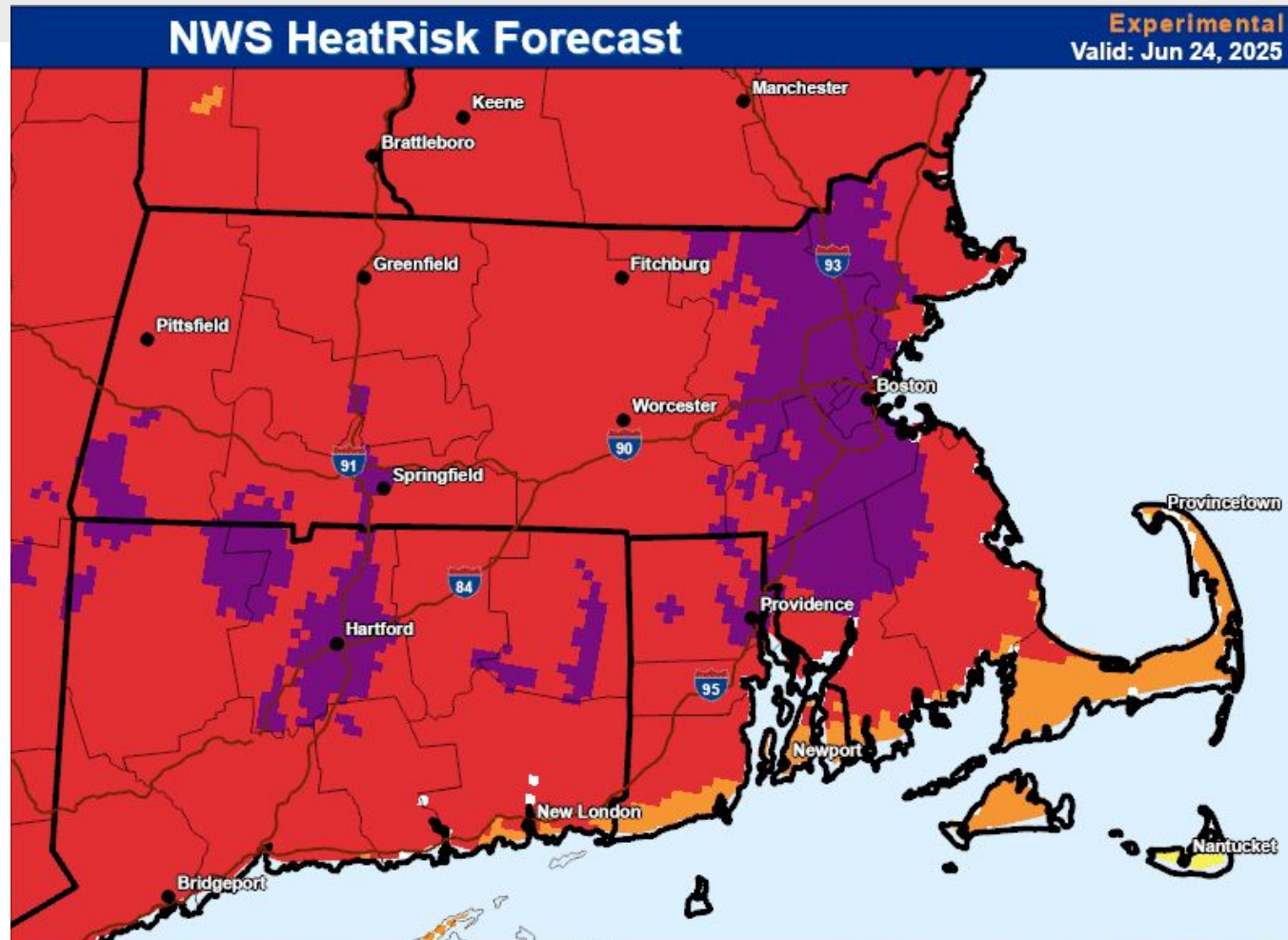

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Little to no risk from expected heat.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This level of heat affects primarily those individuals extremely sensitive to heat, especially when outdoors without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This level of heat affects most individuals sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration• Impacts possible in some health systems and in heat-sensitive industries.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This level of heat affects anyone without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.• Impacts likely in some health systems, heat-sensitive industries and infrastructure.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This level of rare and/or long-duration extreme heat with little to no overnight relief affects anyone without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.• Impacts likely in most health systems, heat-sensitive industries and infrastructure.



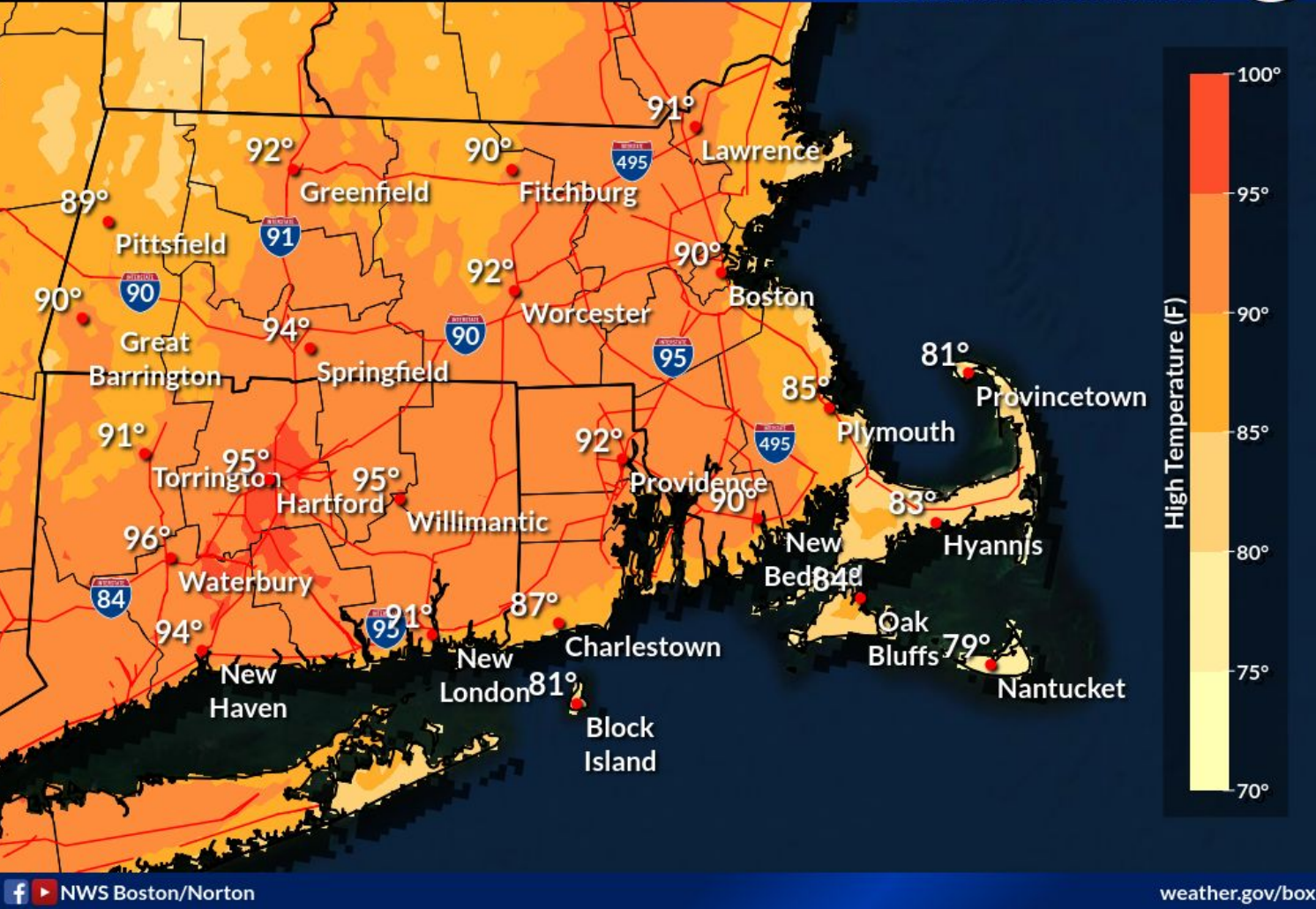

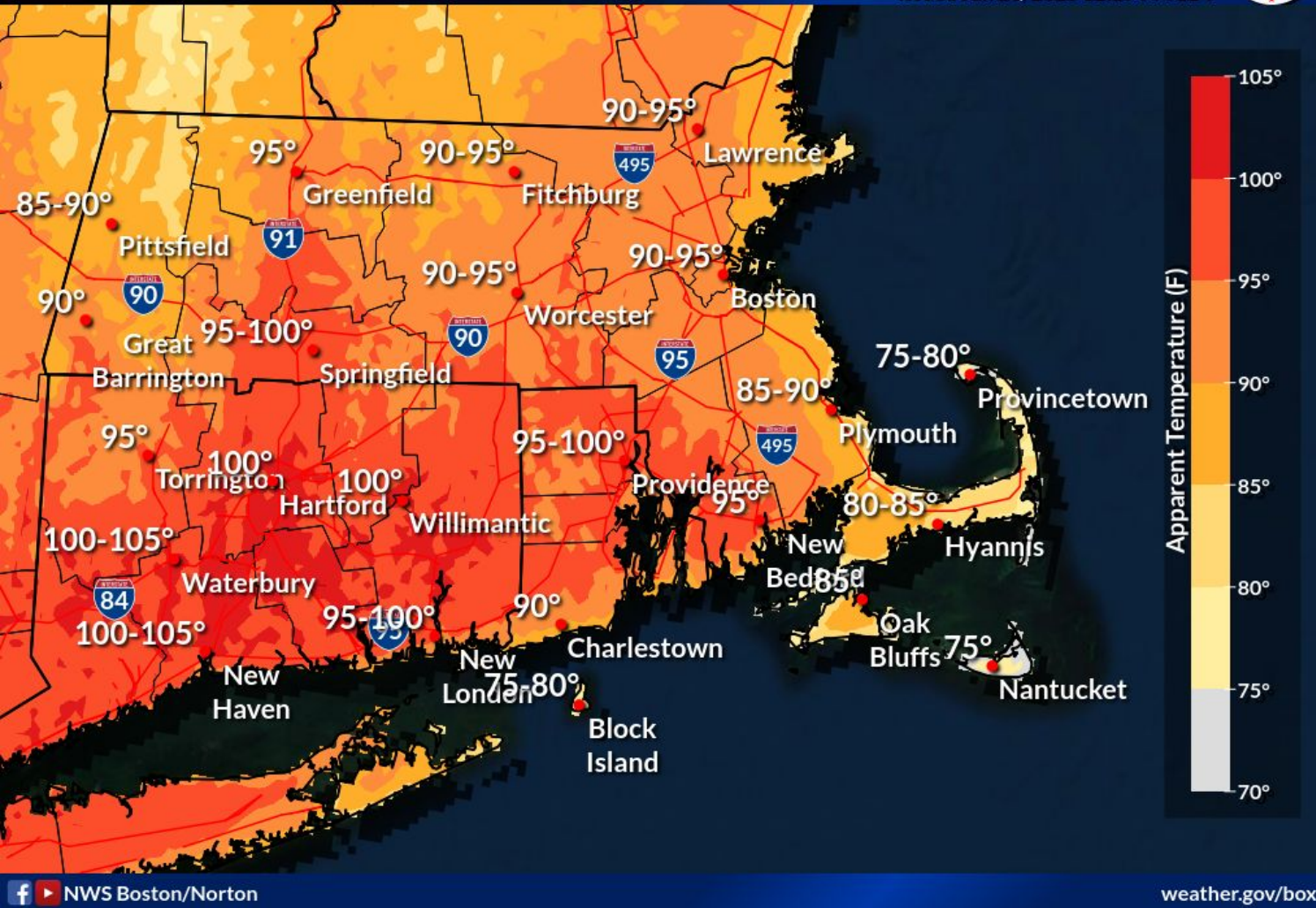

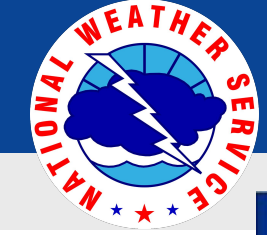
Wednesday - Maximum "Feels Like" Temperatures

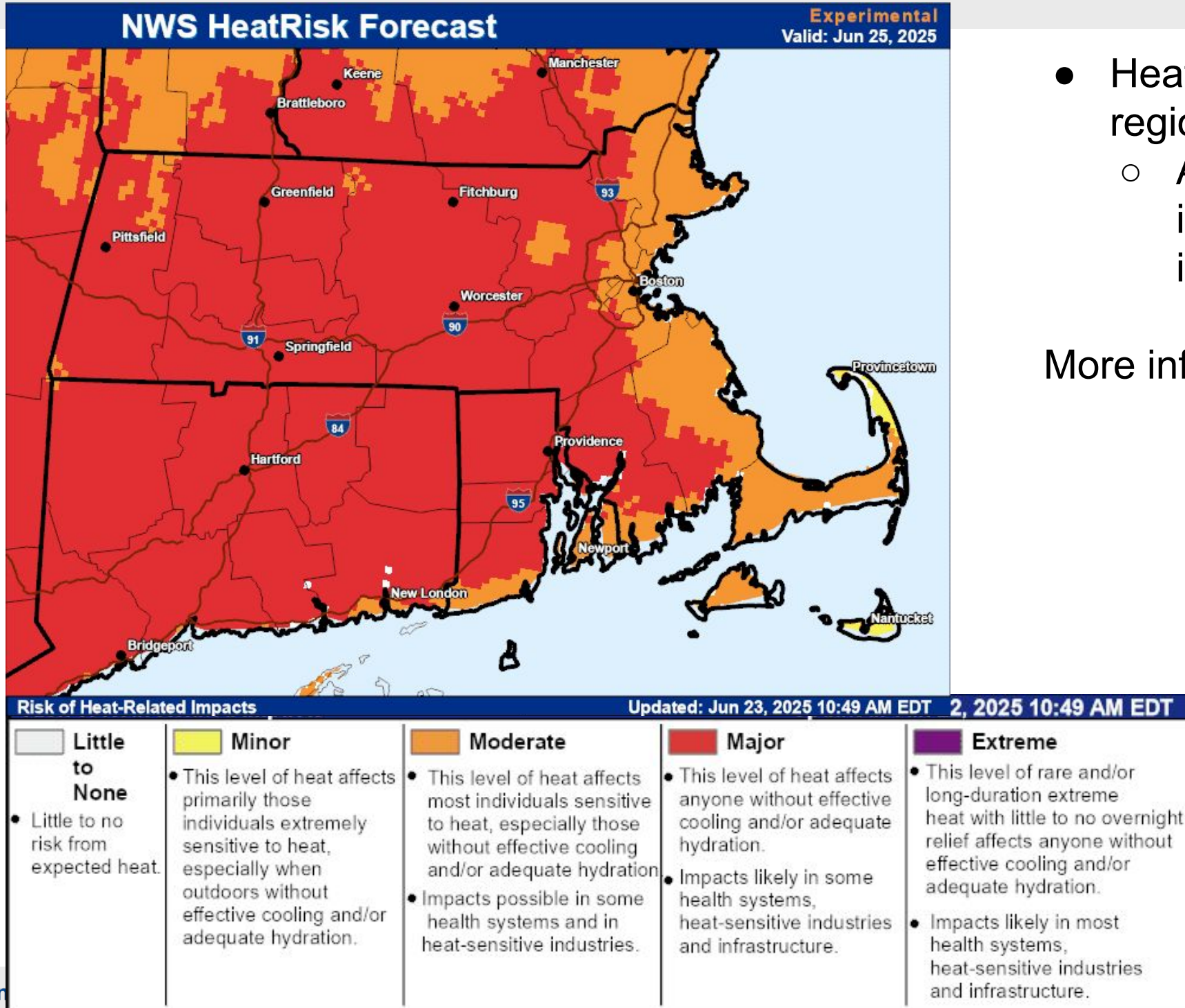

 - Anyone without access to effective cooling is at most risk from heat related health impacts

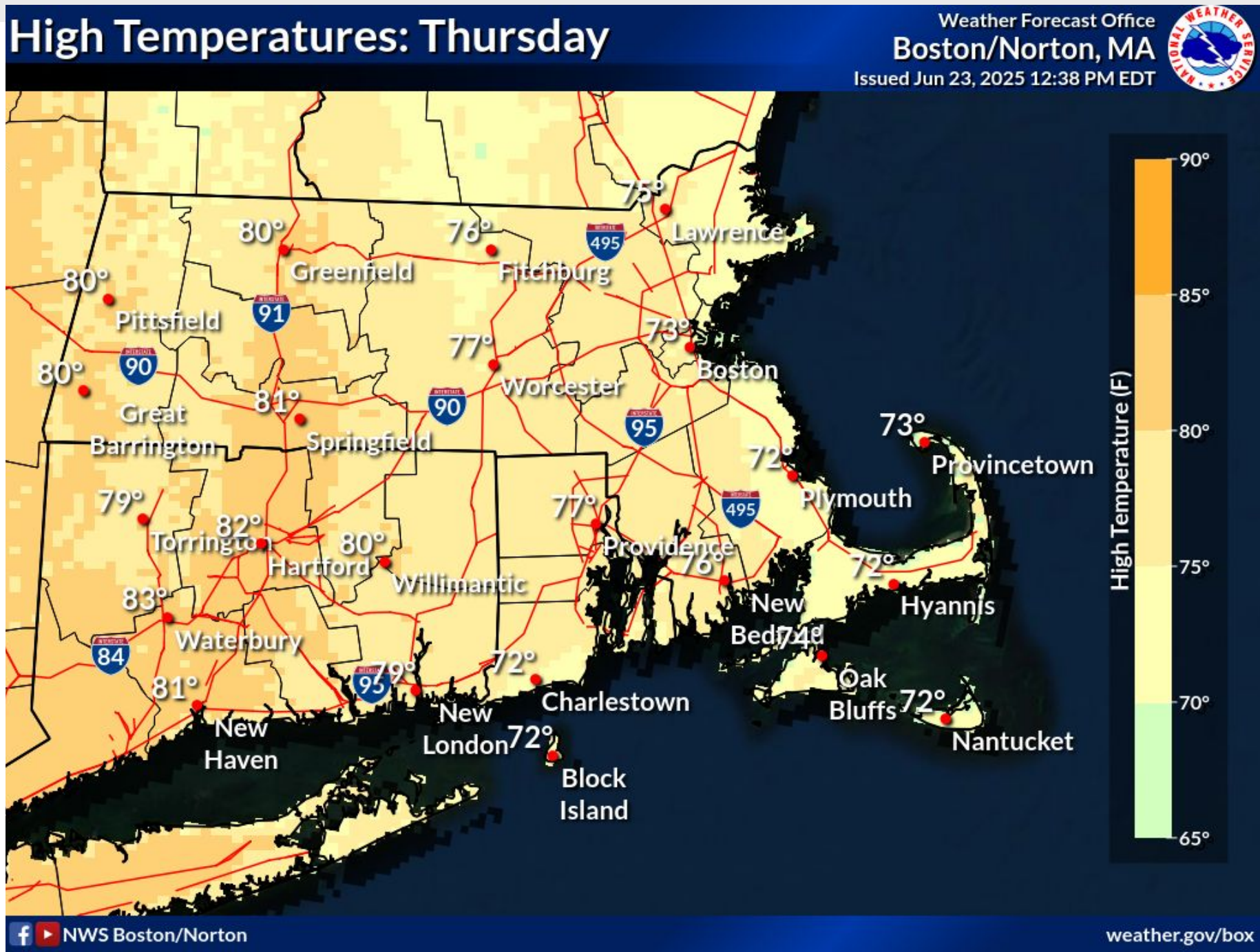
