

### **OVERVIEW:**

- Scattered strong to severe thunderstorms possible 4 PM to 10 PM across western portions of MA & CT. Storms will weaken to just showers eastward into RI and eastern MA this evening.
- Damaging straight-line wind gusts are the primary threat, with an isolated tornado and brief heavy rain as a secondary threat.

## TIMING

- Greatest risk for severe thunderstorms today/Saturday is between 4 PM and 10 PM, with highest highest probabilities between 6 PM to 9 PM.
- The severe weather threat is confined to western portions of MA & CT

### **HAZARDS & IMPACTS**

- Downed trees and/or powerlines from straight-line winds or an isolated tornado.
- Urban or poor drainage street flooding from torrential rain.
