

OVERVIEW:

- Scattered strong to severe thunderstorms possible 3 PM to 9 PM across southern New England, with greatest risk from interior MA into CT.
- Damaging straight-line wind gusts are the primary threat, but locally heavy rainfall capable of flash flooding is also possible.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Greatest risk for severe thunderstorms and heavy rainfall is between 3 PM and 9 PM, especially from interior MA into CT. 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Downed trees and/or powerlines from straight-line winds ▪ Urban and poor drainage street flooding from locally heavy rainfall ▪ Heat indices reaching the mid 90s away from the south coast 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Morning showers and t-storms may impact how much instability develops in the afternoon. ▪ Some forecast uncertainty regarding the areal coverage and severity of storms, and how much storms will weaken as they approach the coast. 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Very warm and a bit less humid Wednesday. ▪ Scattered t-storms possible Thu afternoon.
