OVERVIEW:

- Scattered strong to severe thunderstorms possible 3 PM to 9 PM across southern New England, with greatest risk from interior MA into CT.
- Damaging straight-line wind gusts are the primary threat, but locally heavy rainfall capable of flash flooding is also possible.

TIMING

• Greatest risk for severe thunderstorms and heavy rainfall is between 3 PM and 9 PM, especially from interior MA into CT.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Downed trees and/or powerlines from straight-line winds
- Urban and poor drainage street flooding from locally heavy rainfall
- Heat indices reaching the mid 90s away from the south coast

None **NWS ALERTS**

- Morning showers and t-storms may impact how much instability develops in the afternoon.
 - Some forecast uncertainty regarding the areal coverage and severity of storms, and how much storms will weaken as they approach the coast.
