


OVERVIEW:

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Heat related issues particularly to those most vulnerable without access to effective cooling and hydration.		
NWS ALERTS	▪ No Headlines at this time. ▪ Heat Headlines will likely be needed for several days next week.		
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ The magnitude of the heat and humidity as well its duration.

NEXT BRIEFING	▪ Another briefing will be issued by Monday morning.	<div><div><div>Little to None</div><div>• Little to no risk from expected heat.</div></div><div><div>Minor</div><div>• This level of heat affects primarily those individuals extremely sensitive to heat, especially when outdoors without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.</div></div><div><div>Moderate</div><div>• This level of heat affects most individuals sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. • Impacts possible in some health systems and in heat-sensitive industries.</div></div><div><div>Major</div><div>• This level of heat affects anyone without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. • Impacts likely in some health systems, heat-sensitive industries and infrastructure.</div></div><div><div>Extreme</div><div>• This level of rare and/or long-duration extreme heat with little to no overnight relief affects anyone without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. • Impacts likely in most health systems.</div></div></div>
