

Severe T-Storms Possible Sun PM



OVERVIEW:

- Scattered severe thunderstorms possible Sunday afternoon and evening. Greatest risk interior but severe weather possible along the coast.
- Damaging straight line wind gusts are the main concern.
- Heavy rainfall and localized street flooding possible Sunday morning, especially near the south coast

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Severe thunderstorm risk - between 2 PM and 8 PM Sunday.▪ Heavy rainfall and localized flood risk - between 6 AM and 11 AM Sunday.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Downed trees and wires are possible in any severe thunderstorm.▪ Street flooding from localized heavy rainfall, especially near south coast.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ None at this time.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Areal extent of t-storms Sun afternoon and will stronger storms reach the south coast.▪ Location of potential t-storms and heavy rainfall Sun morning is uncertain.
