

OVERVIEW:

- Localized flooding possible as steady rainfall moves into Southern New England from Thursday afternoon through early Friday afternoon.
- Widespread rainfall amounts of I-2 inches are anticipated, with localized totals of 3-4 inches possible. Those areas receive 3-4 inches are at the greatest risk for flooding, notably the hilly terrain of northern and western Connecticut.

TIMING

 Widespread soaking rainfall is expected from Thursday afternoon through early Friday, followed by drier conditions developing Friday afternoon.

HAZARDS &

Rainfall could lead to localized flooding in flood-prone areas.
Rises on small streams and creeks to bankfull are possible, though no

flooding is anticipated on mainstem rivers.

FORECAST

NWS ALERTS

 Onset and departure of the rainfall and the placement of the heaviest rainfall.

All of Connecticut is under a Flood Watch from 2 PM Thursday through 2
