




OVERVIEW:

- Localized flooding possible as steady rainfall moves into Southern New England from this afternoon through early Friday afternoon.
- Widespread rainfall amounts of 1–2 inches are anticipated, with localized totals of 3–4 inches possible. Those areas receive 3-4 inches are at the greatest risk for flooding, notably the hilly terrain of northern and western Connecticut.

TIMING	▪ Widespread soaking rainfall is expected from this afternoon through early Friday, followed by drier conditions developing Friday afternoon.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Rainfall could lead to localized flooding in flood-prone areas. ▪ Rises on small streams and creeks to bankfull are possible, though no flooding is anticipated on mainstem rivers.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ All of Connecticut is under a Flood Watch from 2 PM today through 8 AM Friday. This watch now ends 6 hours earlier.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Onset and departure of the rainfall and the placement of the heaviest rainfall.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	▪ Drier and cooler conditions are expected for the upcoming weekend.
