

# Isolated Severe Storms Wednesday

## OVERVIEW:

- Isolated strong to severe thunderstorms possible 2 PM to 10 PM across southern New England, with greatest risk generally north and west of I-95.
- Damaging straight-line wind gusts are the primary threat, but locally heavy rainfall capable of urban flash flooding is also possible.

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ 2PM - 10PM
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Downed trees and/or power lines from straight line winds</li><li>▪ Urban and poor drainage street flooding from locally heavy rainfall</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ None
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Timing of thunderstorm initiation</li><li>▪ How far east will storms progress?</li><li>▪ Overall uncertainty with respect to areal coverage and severity of storms</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Hot and humidity overnight with lows in the upper 60s/low 70s</li><li>▪ Another round of thunderstorms Thursday afternoon with a risk for flash flooding.</li><li>▪ Severe risk is low for Thursday at this time</li></ul>
